

## AGREEMENT

- I -

This Agreement is entered into by and between the United States Army Vietnam (USARV) and the Republic of Vietnam Armed Forces (RVNAF).

- II -

IT IS UNDERSTOOD THAT: The signatories to this Agreement have full authority to represent, negotiate, sign and obligate their respective principals with regard to the provisions of this Agreement.

- III -

IT IS UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT: The purpose of this Agreement is to formalize the intent and understanding of the US and RVN Forces as specifically applicable to the physical and legal transfer of Camp Enari Installation from USARV to the RVNAF.

- IV -

IT IS UNDERSTOOD THAT: Camp Enari Installation consists of 3230 hectares of land in Pleiku Province. It is understood that Camp Enari Installation is an area of real estate shown as the shaded area on the Map Section, Sheet 6636 IV, Series L7014 (APP I), with the boundary starting at grid coordinate 49 PAR 76253000; then proceeding due west for 3750 meters to coordinates 80003000; then proceeding due north for 2000 meters to coordinates 80003200; then proceeding due west for 1000 meters to coordinates 81003200; then proceeding due north for 1000 meters to coordinates 81003300; then proceeding due west for 1000 meters to coordinates 82003300; then proceeding due north for 3100 meters to coordinates 82003610; then proceeding northeast for 2310 meters to coordinates 79723639; then proceeding northeast for 890 meters to intersect road TL/7C at coordinates 79113700; then proceeding parallel to road TL/7C, northeast for 1560 meters to the intersection of TL/7C with National Highway QL19 and 14 at coordinates 78053810; then proceeding southeast for 1400 meters parallel to National Highway QL19 and 14 to the intersection of National Highway QL19 and National Highway QL14 at coordinates 77453685; then proceeding generally south for 4590 meters parallel to National Highway QL14 to coordinates 76073304; then proceeding southwest for

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600 meters to coordinates 76003255; then proceeding southeast for 610 meters to intersect National Highway QL14 at coordinates 76003200; then proceeding generally south for 2030 meters parallel to National Highway QL14 to the point of origin for a total area of 32,800,000 square meters.

- V -

IT IS AGREED THAT: Camp Enari Installation is transferred to the RVNAF as an operational military facility for the sole use of RVNAF, utilization of which will be determined by the Republic of Vietnam Joint General Staff.

- VI -

IT IS AGREED THAT: The final and complete transfer of Camp Enari Installation is effective at 1500 hours, 15 APRIL 1970.

- VII -

IT IS AGREED THAT: The RVN Forces are fully responsible for the overall security of the Camp Enari Installation effective 1200 hours, 15 April 1970 and that security forces for the installation will be comprised solely of RVN personnel.

- VIII -

IT IS AGREED THAT: All USARV personnel not in an advisory position will be completely withdrawn from Camp Enari Installation by 1800 hours, 15 April 1970.

- IX -

IT IS AGREED THAT: Equipment, materials and fixtures located at, on, in and around buildings, facilities and grounds at Camp Enari Installation at the effective time of transfer, as well as buildings, other structures and facilities located at and on Camp Enari Installation at the effective time of transfer are transferred to the RVNAF simultaneously with and as a part of the transfer of Camp Enari Installation. However, the following facilities and the right of access to such facilities will be retained under US control for US Contractor and/or Facilities Engineer Maintenance Personnel Support:
