Dear General Khuyen:

Reference is made to the letter from General Vande Hey to General Manh, dated 18 December 1970, concerning base transfer actions, and to General Manh's reply of 12 January 1971.

An evaluation of requirements indicates that Camp Ogle, Xuan Loc located at grid coordinate TT 463003 in Long Khanh Province is excess to U.S. needs. The facilities, consisting of adequate mess, administration and billeting to house approximately 259 men, are available for transfer to RVNAF provided they will accommodate a unit authorized in the Consolidated RVNAF Improvement and Modernization Program (CRIMP). Informal coordination indicates the 18th (APVN) Division has expressed a desire to occupy the facility. Request you consider the availability of these facilities in light of RVNAF requirements and inform this Headquarters (ATTN: MACDC-RPM) of your desires and proposed use of the facilities.

In connection with base transfer, the spaces for facilities maintenance must come from those spaces authorized in the CRIMP, and no additional spaces will be authorized specifically for base security. In addition, transfer does not imply that Military Assistance Service Funded (MASF) Program funding will be provided for base or equipment support.

It is further requested that the appropriate individuals on your staff contact their counterparts on the MACV staff in order to continue combined negotiations concerning equipment requirements.
