MEMORANDUM FOR THE DIRECTOR OF CONSTRUCTION

SUBJECT: Request for base transfer actions

Reference is made to the letter from Major General Vanne H. Taylor to General
Taylor, dated 10 January 1971, concerning base transfer actions, and to the
reply of 12 January 1971.

In the letter of 10 January 1971, it is stated that the Cam Ly Logistics
Center, located at GP 167218 in Binh Thuan province, consisting of 32 buildings
and a parking area, is available for transfer to the United States Army
for use as a base for the United States Army and Marine Corps. Request
is made for your assistance in the transfer of these facilities in light of
the requirements (ATTN: MACV-REM) of your district.

In addition to the transfers, the spaces for facilities maintenance
and repair are also authorized in the COMUSMACV, and the facilities
are to be used primarily for base security. The facilities are to be
used for the Military Assistance Service Program (MASP) and for
the program for base equipment support.

It is requested that you advise the appropriate individuals on your staff
concerning the transfer of the MACV staff in order to coordinate
with the appropriate individuals on your staff concerning equipment requirements.
