Dear General Khuyen:

Reference is made to the letter from General Bowley to General Manh, dated 22 March 1971, concerning RVNAF Future Use of U.S. Military Installations, and to General Manh's reply of 26 May 1971.

An evaluation of requirements indicates that Camp Holloway, located at grid coordinate AR 810469 in Pleiku Province, is excess to U.S. needs. This headquarters has directed USARV to coordinate with the 2 ALC concerning the transfer of this facility for use as indicated in Annex I to General Manh's letter of 26 May 1971.

In connection with base transfers, the spaces for facilities maintenance must come from those spaces authorized in the Consolidated RVNAF Improvement and Modernization Plan (CRIMP), and no additional spaces will be authorized specifically for base security. In addition, transfer does not imply that Military Assistance Service Funded (MASF) Program funding will be provided for base or equipment support.

It is requested that the appropriate individuals on your staff contact their counterparts on the MACV staff in order to continue combined negotiations concerning equipment requirements.
